Shoring ladder

The TIBATEK Verbauleiter is used in all common trench shoring systems and enables safe access to the excavation pit. The ladder can be assembled to a length of between 3 and 10 meters using 1-meter extension pieces. Not only does it make work easier, it is also mandatory for trenches deeper than 5 meters according to the German Social Accident Insurance (DGUV).

For shallow excavation pits, such as shoring boxes, we offer a version of the shoring ladder with a descent depth of 2 meters.
